

In general

Personal information is all kinds of information that to some extent can be attributed to you. When you use our website, we collect and process a number of such information.

Security

We process your personal data securely and confidentially in accordance with applicable law, including the Personal Data Ordinance and the Data Protection Act.

Your information will only be used for the purpose for which it was collected and will be deleted when this purpose has been fulfilled or is no longer relevant.

We have taken technical and organizational measures against your information being accidentally or illegally deleted, published, lost, degraded or come to the knowledge of unauthorized persons, misused or otherwise processed in violation of the law.

Purpose

The information about you is used to identify you as a user and to be able to provide you with the services you have requested. In addition, we use the information to optimize and improve our services and content in general to you.

Period of storage

We retain information for the period permitted by law and we delete it when it is no longer needed or relevant. The period depends on the nature of the information and the background for storage. It is therefore not possible to provide a general time frame for when information is deleted.

Disclosure of information

Disclosure of personal information such as name and e-mail, etc. will only happen if you give your consent. We only use data processors in the EU or in countries that can provide your information with adequate protection.

Insights and complaints

You have the right to be informed of the personal data we process about you in a standard format (data portability). You can also object to the use of the information at any time. You can also revoke your consent for information about you to be processed. If the information processed about you is incorrect, you have the right to
